TNCC course status: 361 Provider and Reverification Courses taught from June – December. There has been 68 courses taught in January of 2019. 3. Missing course material involving 34 courses and 15 course directors 4. TICER applications: 1 reviewed and accepted: Thomas Hart from Houston chapter. 5. Course integrity issues: One has been brought to the Texas trauma committee. The plan is to monitor her courses. Will be in touch with Course Operations on Monday regarding our next steps and some concerns that occurred at the national level with approval of the courses for this course director. 6. COI compliance: Only 218 out of 729 instructors have completed their COI for 2019. If you have not done this, please go to the national website and complete this as soon as possible. If you do not have your COI done, you cannot teach. 7. TNCC 8th edition update: first webinar was held on January 31st, outlining the overall precourse and course agendas. The course will be released in April 2019 and the Course Directors and Instructors will receive an email on April 2nd with instructions on purchasing the 8th edition manual and a link to the precourse modules. No more 7th edition courses will be taught after June 30, 2019. TNCC will follow suit with ENPC and use the flipped classroom model. There will be 8 precourse modules. All of subject will be discussed in the course as well as the skills stations.
2 nd Quarter:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Update regarding Texas Trauma Systems including legislation before the legislature right now, driver responsibility act is probably going to be repealed which is one of the ways that the trauma system gets our funding. They are however replacing it with increased fees for driving infractions that will fund the trauma system, it should be a wash. Stop the Bleed program is being pushed out to the public schools in Texas. There is legislation requiring children being in rear seat rear facing until the age of 2, it does look like it will pass. 2. Trauma Awareness month is in May and the focus is gun safety. 3. There is a law in the house to add two nurses to the GETAC committee, some resistance to this. 4. We have had 246 provider and reverification courses in the state from January 1 to April 10th of this year. 5. Missing course material in much improved with only 17 courses with 9 course directors being delinquent. 6. We have had to requests for TNCC courses and hae not received any TICER applications for this quarter. 7. Faculty status: Susan Raven has requested faculty status and as soon as she gets the required paperwork and requirements done it will be accepted. 8. COI compliance: 176/745(24%) instructors have not done their COI. If you have not done this, please get it done as soon as possible. You cannot teach without it being done. 9. Course integrity issue: The course that we received a complaint against last quarter has been monitored. Several infractions were found and the report has been sent to the Course Administration Faculty at the National ENA office. There is currently a disciplinary investigation. Will keep

	<p>following up with Course Operations for updates on this situation.</p> <p>10. TNCC 8th edition update. It was released on April 2nd for the Course Directors and instructors to do their update. The deadline for 7th edition courses and instructors/CD's to be updated has been extended to August 1st. There will be 8 precourse modules involving special populations and biomechanics; pathophysiology . There will be increase in indirect fees to \$85 and the cost of the manual has been increased to \$78. There will no longer be a prepayment discount on the indirect fees. It will also be a flipped classroom model. There are updated administrative procedures available on line. It is suggested that you download and review the new administrative procedures.</p>
